

DIRECTIONS to the GROVER HOUSE – our friends of the **Navesink Maritime Heritage Association** are graciously offering NJF Clearwater a permanent office in this building – when it's completed. Please come and see it:

<u>Parkway</u>: Ex.109 = Route 520 East – take the first left – via the jughandle after the Lyncroft Academy bus station (Half Mile Road) – go to the end, take a left at Front Street – The Grover House will be after Sterling Court, which is the third street on the left. It will be on your right, and there is parking in front.

<u>Route 35 North</u>: After Red Bank, turn right onto Front Street. The Grover House will be after Sterling Court, which is after Half Mile Road, the third street on the left. It will be on your right, and there is parking in front.

<u>Route 35 South</u>: After the bridge into Red Bank, take a right onto Front Street. The Grover House will be after Sterling Court, which is after Half Mile Road, the third street on the left. It will be on your right, and there is parking in front.

As usual, we will have (a) Featured Leader-Performer(s). Ingrid Heldt and Isis Ra, the organizers, will also participate, and so can you: Similarly to the Circle of Song Stage at our NJ Friends of Clearwater Festivals, there will be opportunities for audience members to take a turn or two to play – or to sing along – please bring your instrument. But if you wish, just come and listen.
