DIRECTIONS to the BELMAR ARTS COUNCIL (608 River Road – at 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue – Belmar 07719): The Belmar Arts Council is on the north side of 7th Avenue, between Main Street and the train tracks. There's a large parking lot.

From the Parkway (and Route 195 East): Turn from the Parkway onto Route 195 East (Exit 98) – then turn onto Route 35 north – take a right onto 8th Avenue – then a left onto Main Street – another left onto 7th Avenue – look for the large parking lot of the Belmar Arts Council on your

right <u>before</u> the Railroad tracks.

<u>From Main Street South</u>: Turn right onto 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue – then look for the Arts Council on your right, <u>before</u> the RR tracks.

<u>From Route 18</u>: Turn at 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, continue to Main Street North – take left, turn left again on 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue – look on right <u>before</u> RR tracks.

As usual, we will have (a) **Featured Leader-Performer(s)**. **Ingrid Heldt and Isis Ra**, the organizers, will also participate, and so can you: Similarly to the **Circle of Song Stage** at our **NJ Friends of Clearwater Festivals**, there will be **opportunities for audience members to take a turn or two to play – or to sing along** – please bring your instrument.
