DIRECTIONS to the EATONTOWN LIBRARY:

<u>Parkway</u>: Ex.105 = Rte. 36 East – left (via jughandle onto Route 35 North) – right at 4^{th} light (= Broad St. = Route 71) – the Library is on your left, before the Fire Station. Turn into the lot. <u>Route 18</u>: Same directions as from the Parkway. The Exit is 13B (in both directions).

<u>Route 35 North</u>: Turn right at 4th light after the Route 36 crossing (=Broad or Route 71). The Library is on the left, before the Fire Station. Turn into the lot.

<u>Route 35 South</u>: Follow the jughandle (on right) to take a left onto Broad Street – find Library. If you reach the entrance of Fort Monmouth (on Route 35), you've gone too far – make a U-Turn - then follow 35 North instructions.

Route 195 East: Turn right on Route 18 or continue to Route 35 North - follow those directions.

If you come from NYC: Ask the Academy Bus Driver to stop at the above address.

As usual, we will have (a) Featured Leader-Performer(s). Ingrid Heldt and Isis Ra, the organizers, will also participate, and so can you: Similarly to the Circle of Song Stage at our NJ Friends of Clearwater Festivals, there will be opportunities for audience members to take a turn or two to play – or to sing along – please bring your instrument. But if you wish, just come and listen.

We encourage songs about the environment and sing-along songs, but you can do or request others.

The suggested donation of \$3-\$7 is still **split** between **NJ Friends of Clearwater's free Annual Festival** (our 40th in 2015) and **Pastor Sony**'s work on behalf of the homeless and the hungry in Asbury Park.
