DIRECTIONS to the BELMAR ARTS COUNCIL (608 River Road – at 7th Avenue – Belmar 07719):

The Belmar Arts Council is on the north side of 7th Avenue, between Main Street and the train tracks. There's a large parking lot.

From the Parkway (and Route 195 East): Turn from the Parkway onto Route 195 East (Exit 98) – then turn onto Route 35 north – take a right onto 8th Avenue – then a left onto Main Street – another left onto 7th Avenue – look for the large parking lot of the Belmar Arts Council on your right before the Railroad tracks.

 $\underline{From\ Main\ Street\ South}: Turn\ right\ onto\ 7^{th}\ Avenue\ -\ then\ look\ for\ the\ Arts\ Council\ on\ your\ right, \underline{before}\ the\ RR\ tracks.$

<u>From Route 18</u>: Turn at 8th Avenue, continue to Main Street North – take left, turn left again on 7th Avenue – look on right before RR tracks.

As usual, we will have a Featured Leader-Performer(s). Ingrid Heldt and Isis Ra, the organizers, will also participate, and so can you: Similarly to the Circle of Song Stage at our NJ Friends of Clearwater Festivals, there will be opportunities for audience members to take a turn or two to play – or to sing along – please bring your instrument. But if you wish, just come and listen.

We encourage songs about the environment and sing-along songs, but you can do or request others.
