The spirit of American folk music, its passion and sense of purpose ring loud and clear in his performance. His songs have been used in theater and film, have been covered by the likes of Pete Seeger and have charted as high as #10 on the Folk Radio charts.





**Tom Picard** New Jersey singer/songwriter Tom Picard is well-known in the local acoustic music scene. He writes songs in a variety of popular styles with lyrics that range from humorous to sensitive, often with clever wordplays and surprising twists. He accompanies himself on the guitar, ukulele, banjo and other instruments. Tom also runs a number of music venues, notably the Z Cafe concert series in Rahway, New Jersey. He also performs as half of the original acoustic duo *The Guitards*, along with singer/songwriter Gary O'Neill. Tom is also a visual artist and art teacher. He self-produced and released three original CDs: *The Raw Way, Lucky Hat Songs* and *This Is Now*.
